

OUR HISTORY

In 1871, Rochester's first Bishop, Bernard J. McQuaid, envisioned a peaceful, prayerful and reflective garden-like cemetery in an environment that provided natural beauty and the assurance of a Christian celebration of life everlasting. McQuaid, considered a man of conviction and innovation, had a vision to provide a cemetery for generations of Catholics for years to come—thus the opening and consecration of Holy Sepulchre Cemetery on Lake Avenue.

Over 140 years later, Bishop McQuaid's attention to careful planning and high standards continues, with two Holy Sepulchre locations: the first on Lake Avenue, and our newest cemetery, appropriately named Ascension Garden, near Mendon Ponds Park. The settings at Holy Sepulchre Cemetery and Ascension Garden provide the natural garden cemetery envisioned, as well as serene, prayerful environments to gather with family and friends to pray, to remember and to celebrate life everlasting.

Holy Sepulchre Cemetery and Ascension Garden are beautiful reminders of God's creations, with many settings that offer consolation and inspiration for family and visitors.

The cemeteries accommodate traditional in-ground burials as well as above-ground interments in beautifully designed mausoleums that are prayerful and reflective environments. The Christ Our Light mausoleum at Holy Sepulchre Cemetery and the mausoleum at Ascension Garden include a wide range of crypt spaces and dedicated rooms devoted to Saints. Both of these mausoleums provide large chapels for memorial services and personal meditation, as well as visitation areas.

Holy Sepulchre Cemetery and Ascension Garden truly offer many services at both the time of need or during pre-arrangement. Our services include:

- In-ground burials for full casket and cremeted remains, with a choice of upright markers or monuments, as well as flat markers, and natural markers for green burials
- Memorial burial sections for fallen military
 veterans
- Memorial burial sections for police officers, firefighters, EMTs and other first responders
- Mausoleums offering full body crypts and cremated remains niches
- Columbaria for above-ground interment

Natural burials have become popular with a higher consciousness of the environment. Holy Sepulchre Cemetery and Ascension Garden have conducted extensive ecological assessments and have sections that are specifically designed for natural burials, with no interruption in the eco-system.
